The name Kamet comes from the foot of the mountain at the foot of which a fertile supply land develops cereals for the whole of India. This area is synonymous with wealth and fertility - just like Kamet whiskey. Distilled from six-row barley grown at the foot of the Himalayas. It is matured in bourbon barrels, French wine barrels and sherry barrels. Distillery typical Scottish style stills installed in 2012. The creators of this item are icons in the world of whiskey - Surrinder Kumar, who is considered the father of Indian whiskeys, previously working for the Amrut distillery, with which he founded and developed the single malt whiskey program showing the production potential of India, and Nancy Fraley, who is one of the best Master Blenders in America, and numerous distilleries drew from its experience. Her path from theological education through legal practice led her to a passion for the world of whiskey and the search for its spirituality and rules. She currently serves as the Director of Education at the American Distilling Institute (ADI).
