

A devastating fire consumed the entire warehouse in April 1909, destroying over half a million gallons of Irish liquor. But JJ McConnell fought hard for his business and showed resilience and perseverance during this difficult time... In the 1900s some Irish distillers began using the "e" to distinguish their "uisce beatha" from its Celtic cousin whiskey from across the Irish Sea. Scotch whiskey has also become a player in exports, mainly to the US, and some, thinking of differentiation from it, have started adding the "e". McConnell's Irish Whiskey was founded in 1776. ## KAMET Indian Single Malt

The name Kamet comes from the foot of the mountain at the foot of which a fertile supply land develops cereals for the whole of India. This area is synonymous with wealth and fertility - just like Kamet whiskey. Distilled from six-row barley grown at the foot of the Himalayas. It is matured in bourbon barrels, French wine barrels and sherry barrels. Distillery typical Scottish style stills installed in 2012. The creators of this item are icons in the world of whiskey - Surrinder Kumar, who is considered the father of Indian whiskeys, previously working for the Amrut distillery, with which he founded and developed the single malt whiskey program showing the production potential of India, and Nancy Fraley, who is one of the best Master Blenders in America, and numerous distilleries drew from its experience. # MACALONEY'S Invermallie Red Wine Barrique





There was once a little Scotsman, Graeme Macaloney, who found a summer job bottling whiskey and fell in love with Uisge Beatha, the "water of life". He dedicated his heart to finding a way to make a living from whiskey, although circumstances found a way to turn his dreams away. Invermallie is our connoisseur/collector's edition.

Like the flowing river of Mallie, it is an ever-changing series of classic single malt expressions based on unique, one-off single casks or other special selections. With individually numbered bottles, it is sought after by lovers of good Whiskey. This special edition of Invermallie comes from a selected, re-charred Portuguese red wine barrel imported from Europe. This "barrique" has been treated by Dr. Jim Swan shave-toast-rechar and produces a wonderfully complex nose of red berries, dried fruit, demerara sugar, leather, oak and honey. The palate is creamy and fullbodied with layers of tropical fruit, wood spices, dark fruit cake brandy, cigar, cocoa, Maltesers, oats and honey. The finish is long with dried fruit and lingering oak.

# MACALONEY'S Searaidh Braicheaken

There was once a little Scotsman, Graeme Macaloney, who found a summer job bottling whiskey and fell in love with Uisge Beatha, the "water of life". He dedicated his heart to finding a way to make a living from whiskey, although circumstances found a way to turn his dreams away. Invermallie is our connoisseur/collector's edition.

Our first single malt matured in sherry barrels. Not only is this single malt "finished" in sherry casks, but it is matured from start to finish in a combination of Oloroso and Pedro Ximenez STR casks. STR stands for Shave Toast Rechar, developed by the late great Dr. Jim Swan. This made our Mac on Braiche and Invermallie STR huge successes. Now, thanks to our Spanish cooperative in Jerez, we have STR Sherry casks (225L) that imbue solid oak notes, improved oxygenation and charcoal filtration to complement the powerful sherry bomb notes expected from single malts matured in Oloroso and PX. The classic single malt spirit at the heart of this spirit, Searaidh Braiche, won gold at the 2019 World Whiskey Awards for best new brand in Canada and top 2 in the world. Searaidh Braiche also won a gold medal at the 2021 John Barleycorn Awards.

## MACALONEY'S Oaken Poitin

There was once a little Scotsman, Graeme Macaloney, who found a summer job bottling whiskey and fell in love with Uisge Beatha, the "water of life". He dedicated his heart to finding a way to make a living from whiskey, although circumstances found a way to turn his dreams away. Invermallie is our connoisseur/collector's edition.

Traditionally distilled using Irish methods and matured in selected Portuguese STR (shave-toastrechar) red wine barrels, it is the first triple-distilled pot still whiskey in Canada and one of the first outside Ireland. Whiskeymaker Dr. Graeme Macaloney researched the distillation process in Ireland before recreating it here on Vancouver Island. He then layered on the puberty knowledge he learned from the legendary Dr. Jim Swan. Taste: full, creamy and smooth, with cereal notes and a symphony of floral and fruity notes, including roses, honey, nectarine, papaya, apricots, apples and candied orange. It is layered with red wine, black currant, wood spices and a lingering oak finish

The journey of Panama Pacific rum begins at the Las Cabras distillery, a Panamanian sugar mill built a century ago, in 1919. Due to the vagaries of changing global geopolitics, the manufactory fell into a state of neglect and was slowly seized by the jungle. In the 1990s, it was found and saw potential for restoration. Tearing through the overgrowth, a 1922 copper and brass alembic was discovered from American & Brass Works of Cincinnati, Ohio. Las Cabras Distillery was born, and world-class rum was ready for the world!

Panameño sugar cane from the famous La Provincia de Herrera growing region. 



Jim's approach is to cut the agave leaves. While others cut to 5 cm, we cut it to 1.5 cm. The deeper you cut, the less bitterness in the alcohol, although it is much more expensive to produce. For this reason, we declare that Le Tribute mezcal is "pure heart" agave.





### **BEIRAO** Licor de Portugal

Licor Beirão is a Portuguese liqueur from the Beira region of Portugal. It dates back to the 19th **century** and is the most widely consumed liquor in Portugal.

Production began in the 19th century in Lousã, in the Beira region, where it got its name (Beirão means "from Beira"). The liqueur is still produced and bottled at Quinta do Meiral, according to the original secret recipe, by double distilling 13 different aromatic seeds, herbs and spices including mint, cinnamon, cardamom and lavender, from around the world, including former Portuguese colonies in Brazil, Sri Lanka and India. After the plants and herbs are weighed and blended, they are mixed with alcohol and left to macerate for twenty to twenty-five days. The resulting content is then distilled twice in copper alembics.

The use of natural plants and herbs is one of the main distinguishing features of this liqueur. When the macerate is ready, it is added to a mixture of alcohol, sugar and water. This mixture is then tested to make sure it fits the parameters of the secret recipe. Each bottle is girded with a hand-tied ribbon which emphasizes the craft nature of the liquor.






Located within The Lakes District, not far from the southern Scottish borders. The district is entirely covered by the National Park, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It was built in 2011 on the basis of Victorian buildings that conceal within their walls much of the history of the surrounding crops and lands. Based on a Victorian cross, we create our history based on faith, hope, happiness and love. Their result was the first alcohol obtained in 2014.

An extraordinary person, extraordinarily important, a mainstay of our idea of whisky creation based on barrel exploration. A man who worked for many years in the financial industry, he left the corporate hustle and bustle to devote himself to creation and creation. Using his analytical experience, he first laboratory develops yeast combinations to then seamlessly move on to pairing and creating our whisky following his senses of smell, taste and intuition.





#### Genesis

It starts with the choice of barley variety and how it is malted. It was decided that The Lakes would be a non-peat whisky. We have cold, pure water from The Lake District National Park, which, when heated, is added to the milled barley to make a clear wort. Here we can influence the flavor. The slower you do the mashing, the fruitier the resulting spirit will be.

#### **Fermentation**

The wort must be fermented, but now the question is, which yeast to use? Yeast not only converts sugar into alcohol, but can play a fundamental role in creating flavor.

Under Dhavalla's leadership, we currently use a unique combination of yeast strains, which we use on different days and are blended at the end of the week. Our fermentation process takes up to 96 hours, twice the industry average, to achieve the desired complexity and depth of flavor.

#### **Distillation**

Distillation is slow and long with a very narrow cutting point; the greater the contact between alcohol vapor and copper, the fruitier and stronger the resulting spirit will be, to complement maturation in sherry, port or wine barrels. More than 80% of our whiskey is aged in sherry casks for 1-5 years.





The Borders Distillery is the first distillery in The Borders areas in more than 180 years.

The first alcohol was obtained on March 6, 2018.

One of the distillery's highlights is its own Carterhead Still for distilling barley spirits. The resulting alcohol is incredibly subtle and retains the fullness of aromas and flavors.

The southern part of Scotland has been the site of some of the greatest battles and struggles for its independence in the country's history. This character is put into every bottle that leaves the distilleries.

The Borders Distillery is located in Hawick, the capital of the Scottish Borders county. One of the most important reasons why this location was chosen for the distillery is the availability of crystal clear water from the River Teviot.

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The distillery was established in 2018, and in March 2019 we obtained our first drops of alcohol. We use our own barley to produce, triple-distilled, premium quality whiskey. Our barrel depot is used to mature the whiskey and is also the bottling site. Currently, 30000 liters of Clonakilty Whiskey are "resting" there.

In January 2020 we were awarded Best Irish New Make by the World Whiskies Awards and were named Producer of the Year according to Whisky Icons 2020.

Michael and Helen Scully are the founders of Clonakilty Whiskey. Michael is the eighth generation of his family to farm the Galley Head area. His family is one of the first to appreciate the West Cork area and notice its stable climate.

Now they are fulfilling their dream of creating their own whiskey. Whiskey that will be based on their own grain, matured under Michael's experienced and watchful eye.

The Slyrs monastery has given its name to the entire Schliersee region over the centuries - and 1220 years later, also to the very unique Upper Bavarian single malt whisky.

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In 2008, Balcones was nothing more than an idea driven by a passion to create something original and authentic right here in the heart of Texas. It all started in an old welding shop by the Waco Bridge. Over the next year we replaced the roof, knocked out walls, laid bricks, cut pipes, installed copper alembics from Portugal, and built a whiskey distillery inside this quaint building.

Proud of what we had accomplished on our own, we began distilling in 2009.

We always have meticulously selected ingredients because of their richness of flavor. From Blue Babe corn grown in Texas to the first malted barley grown in Texas, we try to make the best use of our raw materials as they create abetter whiskey.

These are unique blends of a bold 3-year-old Jamaican rum full of tropical flavors from Worthy Park Distillery, founded in 1670, and a smooth, honey-buttery 5-year-old Barbados rum from Foursquare Distillery, founded in 1920 and named the world's best distiller for the seventh consecutive year in 2020.





Sakuro Brewery and Distillery Co. Ltd. was founded in 1918 in Sakurao, Hatsukaichi, Hiroshima Prefecture.

For more than a century, our distilling technique has been passed down from generation to generation, and we have shared the experience of our long and illustrious history not only within Hiroshima Prefecture, but also around the world. We continue to respect the traditional techniques cultivated over the years. Sakurao Distillery launches new venture into whiskey and gin production.

J. Bally' story begins in 1917, when Jacques Bally bought a small sugar mill and water mill that had been built in the early 17th century. Bally then turned the refinery into a distillery. With a solid engineering background, he was able to build a new distillation column himself, as well as install a steam engine for power.

In 1924, Bally put all his efforts into maturing his rums. In the 1950s and 1960s, J. Bally's vintage rums gained a reputation as one of the best rhum agricole in the world.

J. Bally is made from the sap of fresh sugar cane harvested in January and February. The distillation process takes place at the Simon distillery, which still houses the original I. Bally alembic.

The distillery is located in the heart of Martinique. The spirits are initially aged in steel tanks for several months, after which they are matured in oak barrels. J. Bally rum is then bottled at 50% ABV with no other additions.





The heart of whiskey may be grain and oak, but the soul of any alcohol is its connection to the place where it is made. We are proud of our roots on the Ards Peninsula and proud to be one of the first whiskey distilleries in Ireland. This pride of place is the essence of everything we do.

Our barley crops are nurtured by the unique microclimate of the Ards Peninsula. The area's unique topography, temperate climate, rich soil and salty air have long made it one of Ireland's best grain growing regions.

Echlinville Distillery in Newtownards is Ireland's first agricultural distillery. We create our spirits from scratch, on land that has been farmed for generations. Every drop is distilled to perfection from barley sown, grown, harvested and malted by hand on our family farm.

In 1613, parson Robert Echlin came to this land from Scotland. 100 years later, his grandson built the Echlinville estate, which now serves as the heart of our distillery.





In 1831, Paul Pomés and Manuel Acha founded a spirits and liquor factory in a small workshop in old, pre-industrial Bilbao. Since then, our family has been passionately dedicated to distilling spirits and liqueurs, secretly preserving the recipes and production methods. The knowledge and experience gained and passed down from generation to generation are our seal of warranty. In constant evolution with trends and consumer market preferences, we have managed to develop and position more than 200 liquor references around the world, invariably maintaining the most demanding quality parameters in our traditional processes.

With invaluable historical value, Destilerias ACHA S.A. is the oldest operating company in the Basque Country, the oldest family-owned company in Spain and one of the three oldest family-owned companies in all of Europe. We have been located in Amurrio since 1884.

In our facilities you can see, still in use, our Charentaise style alembics, made in 100% copper by the house of Hervé & Moulin in the French region of Bourdeaux, which were acquired by our family in 1892 for 10,058 pesetas. In addition, you can visit our beautiful and complete distillation museum

Locally sourced, our unique Canadian barley, with island water and air, yields a complex but balanced spirit, while ensuring the impeccable quality of theto the final drink.

In April 2004, both chambers of the Alabama state legislature passed a resolution, now known as Act of Alabama 2004-97, calling Conecuh Ridge Alabama Fine Whiskey "the official liquor of the state of Alabama." For several months it was sold in Alabama itself and the states of Georgia, Tennessee and Florida. To this day, this whiskey is called "high-end moonshine" because it has retained its original character and the full aroma and flavor of the first illegal distilleries.

The story of Conecuh Ridge whiskey begins with the figure of Clyde May, a legendary moonshiner and bootlegger from Alabama. From the 1950s to the 1980s, Clyde was able to produce about 300 gallons a week in alembics of his own design and manufacture in the woods near Almeria, Alabama, in Bullock County, southeast of Montgomery. His product was renowned for its high quality relative to typical moonshin





Before sugar cane was ever planted in the Caribbean, before people first used the word "alcohol," in the lands of South Asia, the people there drank Arrack.

At the end of the 15th century, Portuguese and Dutch traders reached the island of Java. There they discovered Chinese sugar cane and learned the secret recipe for making arrack developed by local growers. The basis of this drink was molasses, fermented for a very long time, then distilled and aged in teak barrels.

Batavia is the Indonesian name for Jakarta, the capital of the country of Indonesia, located in the northwestern part of the island of Java.

Batavia Arrack, then, we can translate as "the spirit of Jakarta," and we can certainly say that Naga rums capture the fullness of traditional South Asian rums, preserving the spirit of the earliest Indonesian distillates.

The malt distillery was established in 2012. Today it is the largest independent malt producer and malt spirit marketer in India.

Our distillery in Crested Butte is located almost 9,000 feet above sea level. The altitude affects our rums - the distillation process takes place at a lower temperature than at other distilleries. This makes the rums exceptionally smooth while retaining the fullness of their aromas and flavors

Aging in barrels at altitude also adds character: the natural temperature fluctuations in our barrel composition cause the rums to "come in" and "come out of the oak" more often. The rums are smoother and offer more complex flavors as a result.

Karen Hoskin's main career over the years was as a global brand developer and marketer - for 19 years she created and built the brand identity and innovation of each of her projects.

She abandoned her career to focus on her new creation - distilling the best rums in the United States.

We use traditional alembics, handmade in Scotland, and the alcohol is matured in oak barrels. We mainly use sherry and bourbon barrels in our production. We also mature whisky in various batches of port, madeira wine and rum barrels.

The original Teerenpeli distillery is located in the same building as the Taivaanranta restaurant in downtown Lahti, Finland. A brand new distillery opened in 2015 at the Teerenpeli brewery 10 minutes from downtown Lahti, increasing total capacity to more than 100,000 liters of new alcohol per year. The original distillery in the city center continues to distill, also allowing for interesting product development.






Las Cabras Distillery was established in 1919 as a sugar mill. Since then, ownership has passed between the government, international investors and failed businessmen.

In the mid-1990s, "Don Pancho" and Carlos Esquivel discovered a neglected warehouse. Under the overgrown grass, they discovered a copper column with a small medallion inscribed "Cincinnati 1922." The skills and experience of "Don Pancho" were soon put to good use, and Las Cabras was transformed into one of the largest rum distilleries in the world.

Panama's central Herrera province is known for its abundant sugarcane fields, which grow in nutrient-rich volcanic soil fed by rivers from mineral-rich mountain springs. The result is cane with the highest sugar content, ideal for producing molasses to make fine rum.





We have affectionately named our state-of-the-art 450-liter alembic from Carl, a German company. It is "she" who provides unparalleled control and consistency in handcrafting craft spirits. Carl is a family-owned company that has been designing and building the world's finest copper alembics since 1869.

Our 25-liter copper alembic is used for small batches and for research in spirits development. It allows us to experiment with new recipes and botanical ingredients.

Traveling from Alaska to the Philippine pearls of the Orient, Peter Westfall has learned about plants, spices and fruits unheard of to Europeans. Using his scientific knowledge in creating distillation processes and combining it with learning about new ingrediences, he creates the first, kraft distillery in the Philippines.

Today, the distillery is now headed by the third generation of the Westfall family, and their journey in learning about the "new", has spanned over 100 years.

George moved from England to Zimbabwe in 1956, after serving in World War II. Both men had a deep love for Africa

The compass, which represents an iconic symbol in rum history, points 11 degrees west. The direction signifies true north calculated from Victoria Falls at the time William and George lived in Africa. True north interpreted as "the right path" signifies "integrity" as a core value of our brand. While the font was taken from George's birth certificate, the handwriting was taken from a special letter William wrote to his wife decades ago. It helps us remember that such strong love pushes us forward in the pursuit of true happiness.

It is the first distillery in South Africa to produce Rhum Agricole, a rum based on fermented sugar cane juice.





Nativo Rum rests in American oak bourbon barrels. Oak bourbon barrels give the final touch to our product. The barrels undergo a "baptism by fire" to revive the trapped compounds of previous generations of rums. Barrels are carefully selected for their contribution to the aroma, color and flavor of the final blend.

We use 10% new barrels to have a unique profile and flavor. The proportion of angels: we lose 12% per year, 2nd and 3rd year 8% and it is replenished with other barrels from the same year again.

The journey begins with the harvesting of sugarcane near Panama. Panama is located between the Pacific Ocean and the tropical rainforest in the northern part of Panama.

Panama is a tropical paradise with average temperatures ranging from 27 to 35 degrees. Panama's rugged landscape is decorated with nearly 500 rivers. This provides the best conditions for planting sugarcane.





There is an old saying that goes: "From Carrickmacross to Crossmaglen there are more Villains than Honest People." A young man was in a bar in Carrickmacross on a bright day and had been drinking.
